COVID-19 cleaning & disinfecting guidelines sent to villa owners/managers

1. It is recommended to ventilate the rooms before cleaning them.
2. Make sure that house staff-members:
 - Get into the habit of washing their hands regularly, using antiseptic soap or hydro-alcoholic gel containing at least 60 ° of alcohol.
 - Wear disposable gloves to handle laundry and what comes from outside.
 - Check their own temperature before getting on the premises.
 - Know the difference between cleaning and disinfection: Cleaning must be done first, using soap or detergent and water to remove dirt, germs and impurities. Disinfection is then done using chemicals such as bleach or alcohol (60 ° min).
3. Remember that it is also important to clean sofas, carpets, curtains and other soft, porous surfaces.
4. Linens should be washed at the highest temperature recommended by the manufacturer. This includes sheets, mattress covers, hand and bath towels, tea-towels and blankets. Clean and disinfect the laundry baskets.
5. Pay particular attention to the elements frequently touched:

Door handles and keys
Garbage cans and recycling bins
Hair-dryers Ironing boards and irons
Switches
Guardrails
Remote controls, telephone sets
Table tops
Window sills and handles

Kitchen

Appliances: coffee maker, oven, pressure cooker, toaster, etc.
Cabinet handles
Condiments: oil bottles, pepper shakers, salt shakers, spices and frequently used containers.
Rigid back chairs

Kitchen utensils that cannot be washed in the dishwasher: ceramic dishes, plastic dishes for children, etc.

Sinks

Bathrooms

Tap handles

Shampoo, conditioner, shower gel and soap dispensers

Shower curtains and doors

Showers, baths, sinks and toilets

Bedrooms

Hangers and luggage racks

Bedside tables and lamps

Cleaning devices

Dishwasher

Vacuums

Washer / dryer

Children's items

High chairs, cribs and toys.
